Bible women are tough, humorous and full of faith. Join the Rev. Lindsay Hardin Freeman as she shares how our spiritual foremothers are deeply relevant to our lives today, and how we might make some of their gifts our own.

A Minnesota-based priest and author, Lindsay has won over thirty awards for excellence in religious journalism. From 2010-2014, she and a research team did something that had never been done before: to document every word spoken in the Bible by women. The resulting book, *Bible Women: All Their Words and Why They Matter*, was co-sponsored by The Episcopal Church Women and Forward Movement. She has served congregations in Massachusetts, Philadelphia, and Minnesota, written/edited eight books, and was the long-term editor of *Vestry Papers*, published by The Episcopal Church Foundation.

Lindsay will be joined by her poet-priest husband, the Rev. Leonard Freeman, who will lead several rounds of the popular **Bible Women Game**.
